

NOW Is The Accepted Time...

Hello, my friend. Do you ever feel that there is just too much to do in life? That the pressures of your job, family needs, etc. are closing in around you? That there is just not enough time to do everything that needs done or that you want to do? Do you ever feel just ready to wake up and find that all this busy hustle bustle is a dream, and you can finally relax?

Do you know what? There IS an answer. That does not mean that we won't be busy, but there is an answer to this weariness, and feeling like we are getting nowhere, like our efforts are totally unrewarded.

Come unto Me, all ye that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light. Have you ever read these words before? Do you know who spoke them? Well, Yahshua spoke them, in Matthew 11:28-30. Do you know who Yahshua is? Look in the footnote below.¹ Have you heard of Yahshua's coming to earth to save man? Perhaps you have. Yahshua lived above with His Father, Yahweh.² There was no sin above. But Yahweh and Yahshua looked down and saw what a sad state we men were in. Mankind has gone quite far from Yahweh's Way. So Yahshua came down, in the form of a baby. He grew to be a man, and spread the Light. He is the Light. He taught the Law of Yahweh, the Way of Salvation, the Road of peace and truth. He spread the Light. He said the following words, and though you were not present when He said them, they are for you every bit as much as they are for the people who originally heard them. Read them again, keeping in mind that the Heavenly Son of Yahweh, on earth in the form of a man, with a heart of compassion for all mankind, uttered them:

Yahshua is the True and Original Name of the One often called "Jesus".

Yahweh is the True and Original Name of the One often called "God", "the LORD", etc.

Come unto Me, all ye that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light. Wouldn't you like to answer that call? Would you like to know a little bit more about it? What does He offer? He offers rest. "Oh," you say, "But how can I have rest? It seems like I'm working all the time, and when I'm not, it's go here, go there. I never get any restful time. I don't see that it's possible." My friend, let us remember this: **With Yahweh, nothing is impossible.** (Mark 10:27) Yahweh can do anything.

Yahweh offers rest to you. Yahshua offers rest to you. Yahweh and Yahshua are One (John 10:30), so if one offers rest, then so does the other. Does this mean there will be no business in life? No, but Yahweh is calling to you now, **Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.** (Revelation 18:4) Yahweh wants you to leave the world behind, and embrace Him. He wants to embrace you. **Wisdom is the principal thing; get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding. Exalt her, and she shall promote thee: she shall bring thee to honor, when thou dost embrace her.** (Proverbs 4:7-8) Yahweh's spirit is wisdom. Yahweh wants to lift you up. He wants to give you peace and rest. If you know Yahweh personally, you can find peace, rest, assurance, and comfort, even when you're busy and tired.

Do you know what Yahweh says in Isaiah 40:28-31? He says, **Hast thou not known? hast thou not heard, that the everlasting Mighty One, Yahweh, the Creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? there is no searching of His understanding. He giveth power to the faint; and to them that have no might He increaseth strength. Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall: But they that wait upon Yahweh shall renew their strength; they shall mount up on wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.**

Won't you leave the world behind? Won't you

fully embrace Yahshua and His Way? **“For My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways”, sayeth Yahweh. “For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts.”** (Isaiah 55:8,9) Come to Him, you and your family. If you totally give yourselves to Him, you will find such sweet peace and joy, such fulfillment and rest. You don't have to bear your trials alone; He is willing to help you bear them. Do you hear what He says in John 14:27? He says, **Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.**

We must not try to keep embracing the world, while also embracing Yahshua. **But ye have not so learned Messiah; if so be that ye have heard Him, and have been taught by Him, as the truth is in Yahshua: that ye put off concerning the former conversation (life) the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; and be renewed in the spirit of your mind; and that ye put on the renewed man, which after Yahweh is created in righteousness and true set-apartness. Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbor: for we are members one of another. Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath: neither give place to the devil. Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labor, working with his hands the thing which is beneficial, that he may have to give to him that needeth. Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is upright to the use of edifying, that it may minister favor unto the hearers. And grieve not the set-apart Spirit of Yahweh, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption. Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamor, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice: and be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as Yahweh for Messiah's sake hath forgiven you.** (Ephesians 4:20-32) We must give up our old way, thoughts, words, actions, and love of the world, and be renewed in Him.

Love not the world, neither the things that are

in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of Yahweh abideth forever. (1 John 2:15-17)

Yahshua said of His people, **They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.** (John 17:16)

Oh dear friend, please do not go halfway! Give yourself wholly to Yahshua! He will give you such sweet peace and rest, the peace, rest, and assurance that fills your heart and life, that makes you glad and at peace even when you are busy. You can talk to Yahweh, and He will speak in your soul and in your heart. Indeed, Yahweh is not silent. He is calling you now. Give yourself to Him now.

Wherefore as the set-apart Spirit saith, TODAY IF YE WILL HEAR HIS VOICE, HARDEN NOT YOUR HEARTS... (Hebrews 3:7-8) Please do not harden your heart. He is calling now. Won't you say yes?

I beseech you, therefore, brethren, by the pity of Yahweh, that ye present your bodies a living offering, set-apart, acceptable unto Yahweh, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that righteous, and acceptable, and perfect will of Yahweh. Romans 12:1-2

We then, as workers together, beseech you also that ye receive not the favor of Yahweh in vain. (For He saith, I HAVE HEARD THEE IN A TIME ACCEPTED, AND IN THE DAY OF SALVATION HAVE I AIDED THEE: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.) 2 Corinthians 6:1-2

“For I know the thoughts that I think toward you,” sayeth Yahweh. “Thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you an expected end. Then shall ye call upon Me, and ye shall go and pray unto Me, and I will hearken unto you, and ye shall seek Me, and find Me, when ye shall search for Me with all your heart. And I will be
